

Contribution regulations of Fair Toys Organisation e.V.

"The amount and due date of the annual membership fee are determined in **membership fee regulations adopted** by **the general meeting**" (excerpt from the FTO e.V. statutes).

1. Free onboarding year for toy manufacturers:

- Toy manufacturers do not have to pay an annual membership fee in their first year of membership.
- During this first onboarding year, new members actively get to know the association and can participate in all training courses, projects, and events organized by FTO e.V.
- The regular annual membership fee in accordance with the membership fee regulations of the Fair Toys
 Organisation (see overview of annual membership fees) only applies from the following year.
- If membership is acquired during the year, the first regular annual fee will be calculated based on the quarter in which membership was acquired.

2. Regular annual fee:

a) Toy manufacturers:

- The membership fee is determined based on the company's annual turnover from toys in the previous year (see overview of annual membership fees).
- Contract manufacturers are subject to the same annual fees as toy manufacturers.
- For the purposes of these membership fee regulations, start-up companies are defined as toy manufacturers that are no more than five years old.

b) Toy retailers:

- The contribution amount is determined based on the company's annual turnover from toys in the previous year
 (see overview of annual contributions).
 - For toy retailers with their own brands, the annual fee is calculated by adding together the annual fee for toy manufacturers (based on sales of their own brands) and for toy retailers (based on other toy sales).
- c) Toy associations: The number of members at the end of the previous year is decisive for determining the

Civil society actors: Civil society actors pay an annual contribution based on their own assessment (see overview

e) of

annual contributions).

Trade unions: Trade unions pay an annual contribution based on their organizational structure (see overview of

f) annual contributions).

Public/church corporations: Public/church corporations pay a fixed annual contribution (see overview of annual contributions).

3. Supporting membership:

- Membership in the Fair Toys Organization is also possible as a supporting member
- Toy companies with a profit motive cannot become supporting members
- There are various categories and corresponding fees for the annual supporting membership fee (see overview of
- supporting membership).

The contribution can also be set higher on an individual basis
